Within the framework of "Regulation on Mevlana Exchange Programme" published on Offical Gazette on 23/08/2011 (numbered: 28034) and "Principles and Procedures on Use and Accounting Treatment of the Amounts to be Transferred to Higher Education Institutions, and Other Relevant Matters on the Payments to be Made within the Scope of Mevlana Exchange Programme" accepted at the meeting of Council of Higher Education's General Assembly on 07/07/2011;

**3.** As per the Article 7 of Mevlana Exchange Programme Principles and Procedures titled "Student Scholarships";

(a) Scholarship paid to students who arrive in Turkey as Mevlana Exchange Programme scholarship students from abroad higher education institutions will be 1000 Turkish Liras (TL) per month, (b) Scholarship paid to students who go to higher education institutions abroad as Mevlana Exchange Programme scholarship students from higher education institutions in Turkey will be as indicated in the table below,
